With over 3.5 million flexible fuel vehicles on the road nationwide, 45,000 right here in Wisconsin, your choice can make a difference!

What is E85?

An American made motor fuel!

- E85 is a motor fuel consisting of 85% ethanol and 15% gasoline.
- E85 is a renewable fuel made in the US primarily from corn grown here in Wisconsin and the Midwest.

What is a Flexible Fuel Vehicle (FFV)?

- FFVs are vehicles manufactured to operate on E85 fuel, conventional gasoline or any mixture of the two fuels.
- FFVs have on-board diagnostics that automatically adjust to allow for operation on E85 or gasoline.
- FFVs provide fuel flexibility - refuel with E85 or when E85 is not available, refuel on conventional gasoline with ease.
- Refueling a FFV on E85 is the same as refueling with gasoline.
